Dear Göteborgs Spårvägar!

Mykolaiv City Council hereby confirms its strong interest in receiving a donation of M29 tram vehicles from the City of Gothenburg.

Following technical exchanges and meetings between our municipal operator, Municipal enterprise of Mykolaiv City Council "Mykolaivelektrotrans" and Göteborgs Spårvägar, we confirm that there is a shared understanding that it is technically feasible for Mykolaiv to receive, adapt, and operate the vehicles. The City of Mykolaiv and ME MCC "Mykolaivelektrotrans" have the capacity to plan and implement the necessary adaptations and preparations required for safe and effective operation in Mykolaiv.

This confirmation is provided to support internal assessments and subsequent procedural steps and does not constitute a binding commitment at this stage.

The City of Mykolaiv confirms its readiness to:

- receive the vehicles and arrange local acceptance, handling, and commissioning procedures;
- act as the formal beneficiary and needs owner for any Request for Assistance submitted via the relevant Ukrainian authorities to the European Union Civil Protection Mechanism (ERCC), should this channel be used; and
- proceed in close coordination with Swedish and European partners in order to implement the donation in a transparent and structured manner.

Mykolaiv City Council further confirms that Dr. Ragnar Lund (Tertius AB) has been asked to assess and coordinate this process, and is assigned to support and coordinate the engagement with partners in Sweden and within the European Union, in close cooperation with the City administration and ME MCC "Mykolaivelektrotrans".

We appreciate the constructive dialogue with Göteborgs Spårvägar and look forward to continuing this cooperation in support of resilient public transport in Mykolaiv.
