Welcome to Regnbågshuset, a place where you can meet up, engage with, socialize, share information and create with other people.

Regnbågshuset is a meeting place for everyone in the LGBTQI community. Here you can meet, organize and create together with others.

Who is Regnbågshuset for?

All activities in Regnbågshuset are created by, with and for the LGBTQI community. This means that all activities should also focus on LGBTQI people or to inform and raise awareness of LGBTQI issues. Regnbågshuset is for the entire LGBTQI community in and around Gothenburg, regardless of gender, transgender identity or expression, ethnicity, religion or other beliefs, disability, sexual orientation or age.

What happens in Regnbågshuset?

Individual people, groups, associations, organizations, networks and projects within the LGBTQI community arrange activities for the meeting place. What happens in Regnbågshuset is therefore guided by the interests, wishes and needs of the LGBTQI community itself.

The City of Gothenburg provides staff to coordinate the activities and run the open house. The City of Gothenburg also covers the cost of the premises and their operation.

Open house

If you want to visit Regnbågshuset, you are always welcome to the open house when there are no planned activities going on. The open house at Regnbågshuset is held every Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday from 15–18, and the first Saturday and Sunday of each month between 10–18.

Participate in an activity

Every Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, and the first weekend of every month are days in which activities created by, with and for the LGBTQI community are held. In those days, the organizer of each event is responsible for the visitors to Regnbågshuset.
