Kulturskolan offers courses and activities to anyone between the ages of 6 and 19 years old. Here you can try out singing, dancing, working with film, art, ceramics, circus, playing theater or an instrument, and much more. Our goal is to make your leisure time meaningful.

We base our work on children and young people

Kulturskolan's natural starting point is children and young people. Our artistic and educational service is based first and foremost on article 31 of the Convention on the Rights of the Child, which states that all children and young people have the right to culture.

"States Parties shall respect and promote the right of the child to participate fully in cultural and artistic life and shall encourage the provision of appropriate and equal opportunities for cultural, artistic, recreational and leisure activity".

We also base our work on the political objectives of the municipality, which says that children and young people should be given the opportunity to experience culture and develop their creative skills. Kulturskolan wants to make it possible for children and young people to discover, express and experience art and culture!

Kulturskolan will:

- provide children and young people aged 6–19 with artistic and educational activities through a diverse range of cultural and artistic expressions,
- provide high quality activities with the possibility of both specialization and diversification,
- provide a range of activities that are flexible in their practice and form,
- carry out activities mainly during children and young people's leisure time and to make it meaningful,
- enable children and young people to participate in planning the activities,
- be a meeting place for artistic, personal and social development where children and young people from all parts of Gothenburg can meet,
- provide equitable activities that are accessible to all children and young people aged 6–19, and contribute to a meaningful leisure time for them.

Our subjects and courses

Kulturskolan offers a wide range of courses and activities in various cultural and artistic subjects. These will be held in children and young people's leisure time, which means after school, in the afternoons, and during weekends and holidays. Those between the ages of 6 and 19 are welcome to apply to age-appropriate courses at Kulturskolan.

Courses and activities

Kulturskolan offers both short and long courses. Some take place over a few sessions while others last for a year. Many activities are free of charge, while others have a small fee.

In some cases, you may have to go to a school other than the one you attend to get to your lesson, as Kulturskolan does not have access to facilities in all schools. The schedule is often decided in consultation with your teacher at the start of the school semester.

Please sign up for the courses you are interested in. Whether you are a beginner or have previous experience, you will be part of a group that is as closely as possible suited to your experience level.

We also provide activities during the holidays and open activities throughout the year where you can try out different activities to find out what you might like. You don't need to sign up for these, you can just show up.

Teaching

Kulturskolan offers individually tailored activities based on the wishes and needs of our participants. Teaching takes place in large and small groups and is held in Swedish.

The teachers at Kulturskolan have proper training in their subjects. Many of them are also performing artists. Our teachers are professional and responsive to the needs of the participants.

For those with special needs or disabilities

We offer specific and tailored courses for those with disabilities. We tailor these to your abilities and needs as much as possible. You can participate on your own and there are also courses where guardians or



accompanying persons can participate. Your guardian or accompanying person is welcome to attend or sit in the classroom if you would prefer that. This is done in consultation with the teacher.

If the course you want to attend is not available where you live, you are welcome to apply to another area.
