Important to know about copyright

Some documents in our archives may be protected by copyright law. If you wish to publish such a work, it is your responsibility to obtain permission from the rights holder. You must also provide the name of the author and source.

A work is protected by the *Act on Copyright in Literary and Artistic Works* (1960:729) for 70 years from the creation or publication date, or for 70 years from the death of the author. During this time, it is not allowed to reproduce the work or make it available to the public without permission from the rights holder.

Contact the rights holder

If you want to copy, publish, or distribute a copyrighted work, it is your responsibility to contact the rights holder. If the rights holder is not known, you are obligated to try to find them.

Provide the name and source

When you publish or otherwise make a work public, you must state the author's name (if known). You must also include the name of the office of origin and Regionarkivet för Västra Götalandsregionen och Göteborgs Stad or Göteborgs föreningsarkiv in connection with the image or text, and in the bibliography/source list.

Copyright infringement

If the author or another rights holder contact you afterwards with a demand for a fee for using the work, you will have to bear this cost. Copyright infringement is a crime that can result in fines or imprisonment for up to two years.
